Observation period:

April 28 – May 1

Participants will go out and submit photos of species using the iNaturalist app.

Metroparks will host programs for this event, but you can participate as much or as little as you would like.

It *does not* have to be in a Metropark. You can even participate in your backyard.

Wild species are preferred, but cultivated species can be included.

Identification period:

May 2 – May 7

We are looking for volunteers to help us with identification of observations.
